 <p>Philips Lifeline Medical Alert Service</p>	<p>Provides fast access to help from the Lifeline Response Center at the push of a button, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week</p>	<p>Speeds time to intervention, which may help avoid the need for hospitalization</p>
 <p>Philips Lifeline with AutoAlert</p>	<p>Automatically places a call for help if a fall is detected and a senior can't, won't or forgets to push their button*</p>	<p>Early intervention in the event of a stroke, heart attack or respiratory distress, which can improve the outlook for survival and recovery</p>
 <p>Philips Medication Dispensing Service</p>	<p>Supports medication adherence: Combines caregiver involvement to organize and load the dispenser with the Philips support center to program the dispensing schedule; send alerts to caregivers if a dose is missed or it's time to refill the dispenser.</p>	<p>Enables patient control and independence in medication management which may lead to reduced hospital re-admissions due to medication errors.</p>
 <p>Third-Party Notify</p>	<p>Fax notification to pre-designated parties (e.g. physician, home care nurse, hospital care manager) informing them of an incident when Lifeline was used to call for nearby help or emergency transport.</p>	<p>Can reduce fragmentation of care with timely communication.</p>
